This week we will be learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali and Bonfire Night

To help your child with their learning, here are a few suggested activities you may like to do at home:

- Watch the Diwali episode of 'Let's celebrate' on Cbeebies <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/lets-celebrate-diwali</u>
- Encourage your child to draw around their foot or hand, then cut out their footprint or handprint shape and decorate it. (Diwali is a time when people welcome Lakshmi, the Goddess of wealth and prosperity into their homes. For this reason, 'Lakshmi's footprints' are a common motif associated with Diwali)
- Decorate your home with fairy lights.
- Can your child move like a firework?
- How many words can your child think of to describe a bonfire and fireworks?
